

The Arizona Criminal Justice Commission is pleased to announce Victim Information and Notification Everyday (VINE).

Please read the following criteria and guidelines before submitting your agency's information for review:

- The agency/organization must provide services in Arizona, regardless of where the agency is located. Services include emergency support, basic needs, counseling, healthcare, legal/financial support, and children's services.
- For non-profit organizations, the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission may request one of the following:
 - A copy of the IRS letter designating the organization as a 501(C)(3) non-profit;
 - A statement from the state taxing authority or state Secretary of State, or other similar official certifying that the organization is a non-profit operating within the state; or
 - A certified copy of the applicant's certificate of incorporation or similar document.
 - Any item above, if that item applies to a state or national parent organization
- Agencies/organizations will be responsible for updating and maintaining their own information. Failure to update annually will be grounds for removal from the directory.
- Questions about inclusion or exclusion from the directory may be directed to the Arizona VINE Program Manager.
- Arizona VINE reserves the right to include or exclude any agency or organization at its discretion.

The following will be excluded from participating:

- Agencies/organizations that discriminate against individuals based on race, age, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or similar factors.
- Agencies/organizations that misrepresent themselves or their services in any way, including non-delivery of services, or that are engaged in illegal or fraudulent activities.
